Effective for all FY 2012 Turnpike-let design-bid-build projects, as part of the production e-delivery, design consultants should include the electronic comp book(s) in the *preestim* folder as shown below:

Turnpike Construction has requested electronic PDF files of the comp book(s) instead of hardcopy. Therefore, **design consultants are no longer required to submit two (2) hardcopy comp books as part of the project production deliverables.**

Since 2005 when FDOT Electronic Delivery began, all design files used to produce the plans, specs + comp book are provided on the production e-delivery disc. Design consultants should continue to adhere to this knowing the design data will be used, when necessary, by Turnpike Construction for verification of geometric criteria for quantities and automated machine guidance.
